Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate and earn the degree of Associates of Applied Science in Echocardiography, students must:

- Satisfy all prerequisites with a minimum grade of 'C' in each course.
- Satisfy all corequisites with a minimum grade of 'C' in each course.
- Complete a minimum of 24 transfer credits with a minimum grade of 'C' in each course before the end of the program (includes prerequisite and corequisite classes)
- Complete the 37-credit hour program with a minimum grade of "C" in each course. The courses include:

 - ECHO 130: Clinical Experience I
 - ECHO 140: Clinical Experience II
 - ECHO 150: Clinical Experience III
 - ECHO 220: Advanced Cardiac Imaging
 - ECHO 230: Clinical Experience IV
 - ECHO 240: Clinical Experience V
 - ECHO 250: Clinical Experience VI
- Complete a minimum of 800 clinical hours
- Attain an overall minimum GPA of 2.5 in courses completed at St. Anthony School of Echocardiography.
- Be in good standing without any unresolved disciplinary actions.
- Tuition must be paid in full.
